## Welcome to Old Gippstown

We hope that you enjoy your experience into the past with some very exciting exhibits put on just for you by our wonderful volunteers. Some of our exhibits are very old and we ask that you treat them with care and respect.

We do have some rules here at old gippstown and would ask teachers and helpers to help with monitoring these: some rules include:

- No climbing on machinery or buildings
- Please keep away from the creek for your own safety
- Don't chase the animals that live here at old gippstown
- Don't climb on any dirt piles or rubbish you may see the workers using
- Also please keep away from the workers around the park and if you see any tools lying around please leave them as some equipment here are quit dangerous.

Children must be supervised when going to the toilet at all times and we ask that teachers and parent helpers move quickly from one activity to the next. Please keep together and stay on the footpaths.
